Senator CHERRY (Queensland) (11.34 pm)—The Democrats seek to delete schedule 2 from the Superannuation Budget Measures Bill 2004. This would mean that all aspects of the bill which deal with the surcharge reduction for high income earners would be deleted. It would leave the co-contribution in the bill, ensuring that that could proceed as a full measure, as it is supported by the vast majority of the chamber. I think that the surcharge should be dealt with at a separate time, as I said earlier.
